Notification

As approved by the Academic Council and Board of Management in its meetings held on 9.2.2022 and 30.3.2022 respectively, it is notified for the information of all the concerned that the Policy for Women Applications, Entry and Participation in the University is prepared as under and shall be implemented with immediate effect.

Policy for Women Applications and Entry

Women Access Policy - Access Participation Plan - Addressing women application - Acceptance - Entry and participation in the University.

INTRODUCTION: Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed to be University) was granted the status of Deemed to be University by University Grants Commission, on 24th May, 2005. Immediately after getting the Deemed to be University status, the DMIMS (DU) has opted for inspection by National Assessment & Accreditation Council, and accordingly Peer-Team from NAAC inspected the DMIMS (DU) campus and its constituent units and accredited the DMIMS (Deemed to be University) with "A" Grade, in March 2007. Thereafter, Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed to be University) was conferred "A" Grade status by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India amongst the Deemed Universities in the Country, in the month of May 2013.

It has been reaccredited with the "Grade A" by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) for a period of five years, in March 2013. Thereafter, in the 3rd cycle of reaccreditation by the NAAC, the University has been re-accredited with "A+" Grade making it a unique Health Sciences University in the County to have such a unique distinction, in the 3rd cycle of its re-accreditation, in the year 2017. Subsequently, it was placed in "Category-I Deemed to be University" as per University Grants Commission (Categorization of Universities only) for grant of graded autonomy, regulations 2018. It has also been included in the list of Deemed to be Universities under 12 B of UGC act, 1956. The University is also received the prestigious Dr. B.C. Roy Award for Institutional Research.

NEED & SCOPE: This Policy of Women Access is towards Women Empowerment through Eduation and encourages equity in every respect by DMIMS without any gender discrimination and thereby systematically tracking women application, following up with the women candidates, give and provide access support, acceptance of their applications, entry and enrolment in the University and ensure enhanced completion rate in the University.



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OBJECTIVE: As defined above, the equality and equity of women in education and empowerment is demonstrated in n DMIMS with a robust Admission Process focussing on maximum enrollement of the Women Students is in place right from identifying the prospective students especially women which can be seen from the high rate of Admission of Women Students in the University.

Apart from this, a special tracking system is in place for the follow up of the Women prospective Candidates which is seen from the high percentage of Women admissions in almost all programs, which is made possible by the personal connection established by Call Centres and Counsellors dedicated for the Admissions.
