NOTIFICATION

In partial modification in the notification No. 83 of 2020 dated 21st July, 2020, it is notified for information of all concerned that the revised policy guidelines for selection of Best Teacher, DMIMS (DU) are mentioned hereunder:

“POLICY GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION OF BEST TEACHER, DMIMS (DU)”

Preamble

The DMIMS (DU) is ever expanding, progressive and value based University. The real hallmark of its progress is its quality centricity. It has always promoted and encouraged the good qualities and meritorious performance of its staff. The teachers who had rendered their meritorious services were rewarded by cash prizes, testimonials and public felicitation. The parameters taken for assessing the Best Teacher were purely based on the structured, confidential on line feedback obtained from the students annually.

However, the said mechanism assessed only one domain and other domains of a good teacher such as his qualities of periodic self update, involvement in research, participation in the organization of co-curricular activities for the students, disciplined behaviour and punctuality etc., were not addressed which are hallmarks for the teacher par excellence, who can be a role model for the students not only in imparting the knowledge but also in shaping their personality to make them noble human beings and good citizens.

The selection of the best Teacher shall be on the basis of wider parameters and to choose most suitable and deserving Teacher for this award who shall be felicitated and rewarded during the Teacher's Day celebrations.

- A) There will be four Best Teacher awards in the Faculty of Medicine – one each in Pre-clinical, Para-Clinical, Medicine and Allied and Surgery & Allied phases.
- B) There will be only one Best Teacher award each in the Faculties of Dentistry, Ayurved, Nursing, Physiotherapy & Pharmacy.

The procedure for giving the Best Teacher award shall be as under:

- a) Date of the Award ceremony - 5th of September every year.

c) **Criteria for Selection**

Criteria	Weight age
Students' Feedback Scores	50% (50 marks out of 100)
Other parameters as per the table mentioned hereunder:	50% (50 marks out of 100)

Distribution of weight age of 50% marks allotted to parameters other than students' feedback scores

a)	Research publications in Scopus/Pubmed/High Impact factor journals	20%	Five (5) marks for each publication in Scopus & Pubmed – Max. Marks 50
b)	Intellectual property: Patents & Copyright	10%	Twenty (20) marks for each patent. Ten (10) marks for each copyright – Max. Marks 50
c)	Books & Chapters	10%	Twenty (20) marks for the book Ten (10) marks for chapter – Max. Marks 50
d)	Involvement in co-curricular activities	10%	Perception of the Teacher to be authenticated by Dean/Principal – Ten (10) marks for participation in each co-curricular activity Max. Marks 50

E) A three member committee consisting of Pro Vice-Chancellor as Chairman shall scrutinize the proposals received from constituent Colleges and submit the final list of Best Teachers to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. The committee, so constituted, shall ensure that the whole process is transparent, objective and credible.
