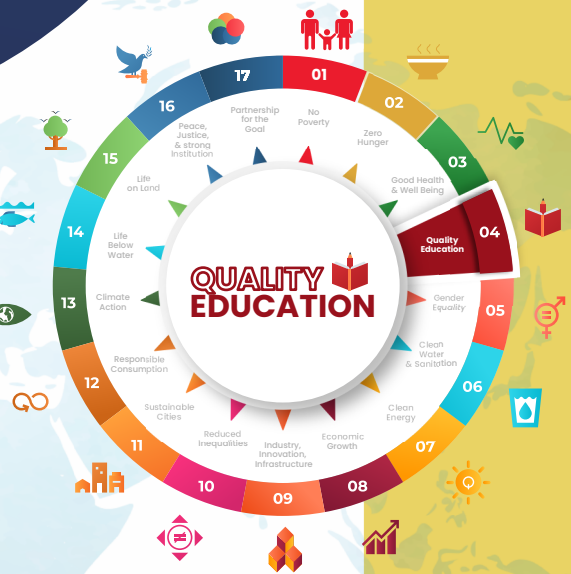
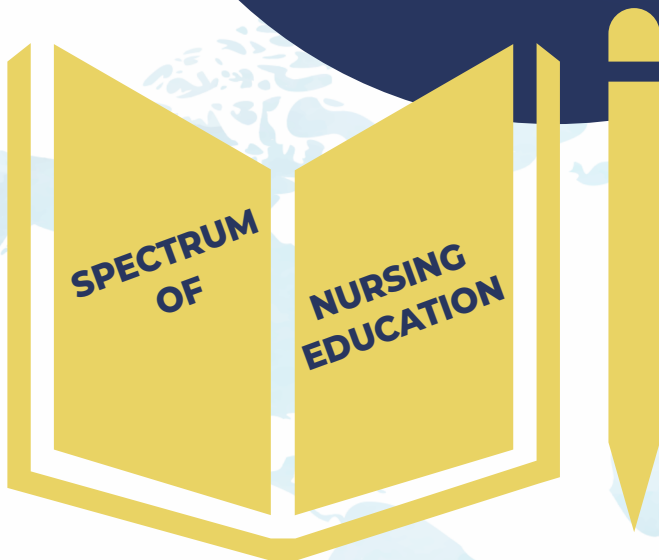

- » Presentation should be prepared in MS power point and heading font size is 36 and regular text is 24.
- » Number of slide 8- 12 excluding first and last slide.
- » Include 3-5 keywords that represent the central themes.
- » Time of presentation 10 min. (8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion).
- » Accepted paper will be informed through the mail on or before 31st December 2024.
- » All participants should email their respective abstract before the mentioned deadline 1st Dec. 2024 in given email id. conferencesrmmcon@gmail.com .

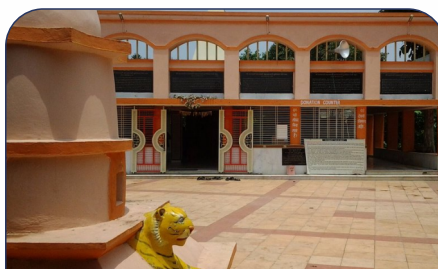

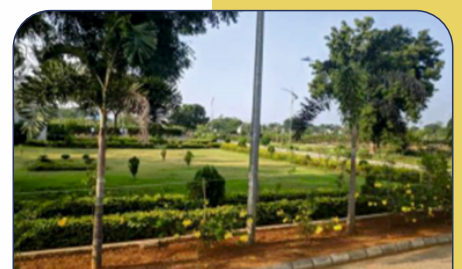
