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



- >> Content should be in IMRAD format.
- >> Font: Use the font style and size recommended (e.g., Times New Roman, 12pt).
- >> Spacing-1.5 line spacing with Justify Align text.
- >> Write the author name in sequential order and highlight the presenting author.
- Presentation should be prepared in MS power point and heading font size is 36 and regular text is 24.
- > Number of slide 8- 12 excluding first and last slide.
- >> Include 3-5 keywords that represent the central themes.
- >> Time of presentation 10 min. (8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion).
- > Accepted paper will be informed through the mail on or before 15th January 2025.
